

SBE 16 Hamburg – Conference program completed

Hamburg Feb11th: The program for the international conference "SBE16 Hamburg" has been completed. The conference covers various topics of sustainable construction with 150 scientific contributions from over 30 countries. Scientists will present their results about strategies, frameworks, and concepts of sustainable construction, neighborhood and urban development at HafenCity University in Hamburg.

Not only European concepts will be up for discussion, but also current research projects such as the 'Green Building' topic in Nigeria, sustainable neighborhood development in Asian cities, and current investigations into the relationship between road construction and sustainable urban development in North America.

The second largest topic is the application of sustainable methods and tools in the construction and property industry. Researchers from European countries, such as Germany, Austria, France, Denmark, Sweden, and Norway will provide findings on the life cycle approach in the construction sector, as well as further evaluation and classification approaches for buildings and materials.

Further contributions concern the implementation of sustainable methods. For example, ventilation systems or lighting concepts as well as the use of photovoltaic and the special consideration of CO₂ reduction in renovation work.

German Environment Minister Dr. Barbara Hendricks and HCU President Dr. Walter Pelka will open the conference on Tuesday, March 8th 2016. Additionally, the organizers, Prof. Dr. Mojib Latif (Helmholtz Centre) and Prof. Dr. Lützkendorf (KIT) are pleased to welcome plenty of reputable international experts from research, planning, housing industry and politics.

The program promotes scientific and technical exchanges through lectures, workshops and special sessions as well PhD sessions for young scientists.

The SBE16 Hamburg offers plenty of opportunities for exchanges with colleagues in order to enhance personal network – whether at the evening reception hosted by the Hamburg Chamber of Commerce or at one of several excursions like a visit to the International Building Exhibition Hamburg.
