



Effiziente Gebäude 2016: Conference on energy-efficient building and retrofitting

Hamburg, 15.07.2016: On Thursday, 29th September 2016, the leading regional conference on energy-efficient building and modernisation “Effiziente Gebäude 2016” will take place in Kiel, Northern Germany. Every year more than 250 participants and 20 exhibitors from Germany and Northern Europe attend the conference, formerly named “Norddeutsche Passivhauskonferenz“. One feature this year is a closer look at energy-efficient building and retrofitting in Denmark, which is why several talks are presented in English.

The conference “Effiziente Gebäude 2016“ deals with different aspects of energy-efficient building, both, on the building and on the quarters scale. This year the conference focus is on the practical presentation of realised projects. “The *Effiziente Gebäude 2016* presents pioneer projects of energy-efficient building and retrofitting and thereby gives new impetus on how the building and housing sector can contribute to the achievement of climate protection targets.” says Peter-M. Friemert, managing director of the organizing company, ZEBAU GmbH.

This year the conference will take a closer look on Denmark, initiating a knowledge exchange between neighbouring countries. One of the talks from Denmark, by Peter Andreas Sattrup (Association of Architectural Firms), is about sustainable architecture and value creation for clients, users and society. Niels Jakubiak Andersen (Krydsrum / e+) will show how to save up to 75% energy and to increase attractivity in urban historical housing areas. Per Alex Sørensen (PlanEnergi Nordjylland) from Denmark will give Danish examples of flexible district heating systems.

Further topics of the “Effiziente Gebäude 2016” are retrofitting and additional storeys for existing residential buildings, innovations in building and technology, users of active buildings, monitoring results from efficient buildings, energy-efficient educational buildings and district heating. In a concluding panel discussion, experts will get to the bottom of the question how the aspects that were presented during the conference talks can be implemented cost-effectively into the building and housing sector.
